



Local Rules

Out of Bounds

Out of Bounds – marked by white stones and white stakes.

- Both sides of the 1st/10th fairway and back of the first Green – white stones.
- Left of 2nd/11th fairway and behind second green.
- Drain left of 3rd/12th tee.
- Right of 3rd/12th fairway – white stakes.
- Right of 4th/13th fairway – white stakes.
- Left of 6th/15th fairway – white stones.
- Left of 7th/16th fairway – perimeter fence.
- River left of 9th/18th fairway

Immovable Instructions

You are entitled to a free drop within one club length at the nearest point of relief, but not nearer the hole, from:

- Sprinkler heads and boxes
- Sheds, Benches and Concrete Waste bins
- Distance markers and Fixed Signs
- Bells and Posts

Rule 24.2 applies if your swing or stance is impeded.

N.B. There is no relief for line-of-sight interference – Rule 22.2

Moveable Obstructions

- Rakes and Stones in Bunkers
- Distance and Hazard Stakes

Rule 24.1 applies.

- A ball hitting the wire or fence post on its **approach** to the green **MAY** be played from its original spot (dropped) to the green, without penalty.



Local Rules (Continued)

Relief

- A ball lying close to the wire at fenced off greens may be dropped at nearest point of relief (not nearer the hole). This also applies to a ball lying on gravel paths, matting or roadway, animal tracks and vehicle marks. Relief from bunker steps (drop outside of the bunker not nearer the hole) also applies.
- Ball coming in contact with animal droppings or animal droppings interfering with a player's stance may be **lifted, cleaned and dropped** at the nearest point of relief and not nearer the hole without penalty.
- A ball coming to rest on any **tee box or green** other than that being played from **Must** be lifted and dropped not nearer the hole, without penalty.
- **Drop Zone** where provided must be used.

No Relief

There is no relief from the perimeter fence on the 7th/16th fairway

Order of Play

Order of Play at 1st and 10th tee boxes is **Alternative groups** with players playing in competition having priority. In the event of two groups playing in competition, the group commencing on the 1st tee has priority.

Other

See Notice Board, in the Clubhouse, for any additional Local Rules

- If Golf Ireland – Model Local Rules E-2 & E-3 relating to Preferred Lies and Cleaning the ball are being played or bunkers are out of play should water be lodged in them, relevant notices will be posted on the Notice Board or the Window Hatch at sign – in.
